Business Leader Elected President of Board of Water Commissioners

LONG BEACH, CA – Today the Board announced the election of Stephen T. Conley as President of the Board of Water Commissioners. He will begin serving his term at the Thursday, October 6, Board of Water Commissioners meeting held at the Brennan S. Thomas Water Administration Building, 1800 E. Wardlow. Currently in his second term, Mr. Conley was originally appointed to serve as member of the Board in July 1997 by Long Beach Mayor, Beverly O’Neill.

Mr. Conley is a principal and founder of Bancap Investment Group, a Long Beach-based real estate company that specializes in investment, development and management. He currently serves as Chairman.

Mr. Conley has had a broad based executive career, having served as Vice President of McDonnell-Douglas in charge of computer systems, Senior Vice President of Union Bank in charge of Operations, and President of Westminster Memorial Park.
